International drivers complete massive Formula Ford grid

Historic Formula Ford is in for a massive weekend's racing at the Phillip Island Classic with the addition of 4 overseas drivers onto their record 55 car entry list.

Most notable of the internationals is FF legend Rick Morris, who is still a very active competitor in FF racing in both the UK and South Africa. Rick is best known as being one of the only drivers who could be regularly competitive against Ayton Senna during his time in FF1600, when Senna was the works driver for Van Dieman and Rick was the works driver for both Hawke and Royale. Rick is driving the Andy Nethercote FF88 Reynard. Rick will be accompanied on his trip to PI by UK team owner Brian Soule of Soule Motorsport, who is keen to bring a number of cars to PI in the future. Irish female champion driver Jennifer Mullan is making the trip to PI, and will be driving Chris Davison's FF84 Reynard.

Other UK drivers include Gaius Ghinn driving the Ian Edgar Lola T642 and Don Boyack, who lived in Perth for 18 years, will be driving the Jon Miles FF83 Reynard.

Other interesting additions to the FF grid include:

1. John Blanchard having his first race in 20 years, at the wheel of his RF88 Van Dieman.
2. 1988 Australian FF Champion David Roberts will be having his first race meeting in 27 years, and he will be driving the beautifully restored Swift.
3. Richard Davison will be having his first drive in his newly acquired RF89 Van Dieman.
